

Third Missionary Journey: Aquila & Priscilla at Ephesus *Apollos: Powerful in Ideas & Words, and Powerful in the Scriptures*

Acts 18:22 When he {Paul} had landed at Caesarea, he went up and greeted the church, and went down to Antioch.

23 And having spent some time there, he left and passed successively through the Galatian region and Phrygia, strengthening all the disciples.

Romans 1:15 So, for my part, I am eager to preach the gospel to you also who are in Rome.

24 Now a Jew named Apollos, an Alexandrian by birth,
~~an eloquent man~~ **a man (who was) powerful in ideas
and words**, came to Ephesus;

and he was ~~mighty~~ **powerful** in the Scriptures.

2 Timothy 4:13 When you come bring the cloak which I left
at Troas with Carpus, and the books, especially the
parchments.

25 This man had been instructed in the way of the Lord.
And, ~~being fervent in spirit~~ **boiling over emotionally**,

he was speaking and teaching accurately the things concerning Jesus,
being acquainted only with the baptism of John;

Matthew 3:1-2 Now in those days John the Baptist came, preaching in the wilderness of Judea, saying, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand."

3 For this is the one referred to by Isaiah the prophet when he said, "The VOICE OF ONE CRYING IN THE WILDERNESS, PREPARE THE WAY OF THE LORD"

John 1:29 He saw Jesus coming to him and said, "Behold, the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!"



26 and he began to speak out boldly in the synagogue. But when Priscilla and Aquila heard him, they took him aside and explained to him the way of God more ~~accurately~~ **completely**.

1 Timothy 2:12 I do not allow a woman to teach, ~~or exercise~~ **having authority** over a man

Psalm 32:1 How blessed is he whose transgression is forgiven,
whose sin is covered!

Romans 3:24 ...being justified as a gift by His grace through the redemption which is in Christ Jesus

27 And when he wanted to go across to Achaia, the brethren encouraged him and wrote to the disciples to welcome him; and when he had arrived, he greatly helped those who had believed through grace,

28 for he powerfully refuted the Jews in public, demonstrating by the Scriptures that Jesus was the Christ.

1 Corinthians 1:11 For I have been informed concerning you, my **brothers**, by Chloe's people, that there are quarrels among you.

1 Corinthians 3:6 I planted, Apollos watered, but God was causing the growth.

10 According to the grace of God which was given to me, like a wise master builder I laid a foundation, and another is building on it.

1 Corinthians 4:1 Let a man regard us in this manner, as ~~servants~~ **under-rowers** of Christ

Hebrews 5:8 Although He was ~~a~~ **the** Son, He learned ~~obedience~~ **to listen** from the things which He ~~suffered~~ **endured**.

Although He was **the** Son, He learned **to listen** from the things which He **dealt with**. *{i.e., normal struggles of life}*

Isaiah 50:4 He awakens Me morning by morning, He awakens My ear to listen as ~~a disciple~~ **someone who is learning**.

Hebrews 5:9 And having been made perfect, He became to all those who ~~obey~~ **listen to Him**
the source of eternal salvation
