

## Paul's Final Missionary Journey: *The Rest of the Story*

**Acts 28:30-31** He stayed two full years in his own rented quarters and was welcoming all who came to him, preaching the kingdom of God and teaching concerning the Lord Jesus Christ with all openness, unhindered.

**Philippians 1:19** I know that this will turn out for my deliverance through your prayers and the provision of the Spirit of Jesus Christ

**25** Convinced of this, I know that I will remain and continue with you all for your progress and joy in the faith

**2 Timothy 4:20** Erastus remained at Corinth, but Trophimus I left sick at Miletus.

**11** Only Luke is with me.
