

## The Two Committees apply Lachmann's Rules to the New Testament Restoration

### *The Shorter Reading is more likely to be Correct*

**Psalm 119:89** Forever, O LORD, Your word is settled in heaven.

**2 Timothy 3:16** All Scripture is ~~inspired~~ **breathed** by God

**2 Peter 1:20-21** No prophecy of Scripture is a matter of one's own interpretation, for no prophecy was ever made by an act of human will, ~~but men moved by the~~ but men **carried along** by Holy Spirit spoke from God.

**Proverbs 30:5 (Septuagint)** Every word of God is tested **and proven**

**Mark 16:8** They went out and fled from the tomb, for trembling and astonishment had gripped them; and they said nothing to anyone, for they were afraid.



**16 (Textus Receptus & KJV)** "He who has believed and has been baptized shall be saved"

**Romans 8:1 (NASB)** Therefore there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus.

**(TR & KJV)** There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.

**(Critical Text)** Therefore, no judgment for those in Christ Jesus.



**Mark 1:39-43 (NASB)** And He went into their synagogues throughout all Galilee, preaching and casting out the demons. And a leper came to Jesus, beseeching Him and falling on his knees before Him, and saying, "If You are willing, You can make me clean."

**41** Moved with compassion, Jesus stretched out His hand and touched him, and said to him, "I am willing; be cleansed."

**42-43** Immediately the leprosy left him and he was cleansed. And He sternly warned him and immediately sent him away

**Mark 1: 41 (Critical Text)** **Filled with anger**, Jesus stretched out His hand and touched him, and said to him, "I am willing; be cleansed."

**42-43** Immediately the leprosy left him and he was cleansed. And He sternly rebuked him {*i.e.*, the possessing demon} and cast him out

---

**Hebrews 2:9** Jesus, because of the suffering of death crowned with glory and honor, so that by the grace of God ~~He might~~ He **would** taste death for everyone.

**(Critical Text)** ...so that, **apart from God**, ~~He might~~ He **would** taste death for everyone {*i.e.*, believers}

---

**Luke 9:14 (NASB)** And He said to His disciples, "Have them sit down to eat in groups of about fifty each."


**Mark 6:39 (Western MSS & NASB)** And He commanded them all to sit down by groups on the green grass.

**(Critical Text)** And He commanded them all to sit down garden bed garden bed on the green grass
