Psalm 119:89 Forever, O LORD, Your word is settled in heaven.

- **2 Timothy 3:16** All Scripture is <u>inspired</u> **breathed** by God
- 2 Peter 1:20-21 No prophecy of Scripture is a matter of one's own interpretation, for no prophecy was ever made by an act of human will, but men moved carried along by the Holy Spirit spoke from God.

Proverbs 30:5 (Septuagint) Every word of God is tested and proven

- Mark 16:8 They went out and fled from the tomb, for trembling and astonishment had gripped them; and they said nothing to anyone, for they were afraid.
 - 16 (Textus Receptus & KJV) "He who has believed and has been baptized shall be saved"
- **Romans 8:1** (NASB) Therefore there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus.
 - (TR & KJV) There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Sprit.
 - (Critical Text) Therefore, no judgment for those in Christ Jesus.
- Mark 1:39-43 (NASB) And He went into their synagogues throughout all Galilee, preaching and casting out the demons. And a leper came to Jesus, beseeching Him and falling on his knees before Him, and saying, "If You are willing, You can make me clean."
 - 41 Moved with compassion, Jesus stretched out His hand and touched him, and said to him, "I am willing; be cleansed."
 - 42-43 Immediately the leprosy left him and he was cleansed. And He sternly warned him and immediately sent him away

- (Critical Text) 41 Filled with anger, Jesus stretched out His hand and touched him, and said to him, "I am willing; be cleansed."
 - **42-43** Immediately the leprosy left him and he was cleansed. And He sternly rebuked him {*i.e.*, the possessing demon} and cast him out

Hebrews 2:9 Jesus, because of the suffering of death crowned with glory and honor, so that by the grace of God He — would taste death for everyone.

(Critical Text) ...so that, apart from God, He <u>might</u> would taste death for everyone {i.e., believers}

Luke 9:14 (NASB) And He said to His disciples, "Have them sit down to eat in groups of about fifty each."

Mark 6:39 (Western MSS and NASB) And He commanded them all to sit down by groups on the green grass.

(Critical Text) And He commanded them all to sit down garden bed garden bed on the green grass

Requirements for salvation:
