Psalm 119: 89 Forever, O LORD, Your word is settled in heaven.

2 Timothy 3: 16 All Scripture is <u>inspired</u> breathed by God

2 Peter 1: 20-21 No prophecy of Scripture is a matter of one's own interpretation, for no prophecy was ever made by an act of human will,

but men moved by the but men carried along by Holy Spirit spoke from God.

Ephesians 1: 1 Paul, an apostle of Christ Jesus by the will of God, to the saints who are at Ephesus and in Christ Jesus who believe

- **Ephesians 6: 21** But that you also may know about my circumstances, how I am doing, Tychicus, the beloved brother and faithful minister in the Lord, will make everything known to you.
- Colossians 4: 16 When this letter is read among you, have it also read in the church of the Laodiceans; and you, for your part read my letter that is coming from Laodicea.
- **Ephesians 1: 4** just as He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we would be holy and blameless before Him.
- **Ephesians 1: 15-17** For this reason I too, having heard of the faith in the Lord Jesus which exists among you and your love for all the saints, do not cease giving thanks for you, while making mention of you in my prayers; that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give to you a spirit of wisdom and of revelation in the knowledge of Him.

13 – 14 For He rescued us <u>from the domain</u> out of the authority of darkness, and transferred us to the kingdom of His beloved Son, in whom we have redemption, <u>the forgiveness</u> the erasing of sins.
1 Corinthians 2: 11 For who among men knows the thoughts of a man except the spirit of the man which is in him? Even so the thoughts of God no one knows except the Spirit of God.
12 Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, so that we may know the things freely given to us by God,
13 which things we also speak, not in words taught by human wisdom, but in those taught by the Spirit, — combining spiritual thoughts with spiritual words—combining Spiritual spiritual.
