

Applying Lachmann's Five Rules to 1 Corinthians 14: 34 & 35 Women in the Church

Psalm 119: 89 Forever, O LORD, Your word is settled in heaven.

2 Timothy 3: 16 All Scripture is ~~inspired~~ **breathed** by God

2 Peter 1: 20-21 No prophecy of Scripture is a matter of one's own interpretation, for no prophecy was ever made by an act of human will,
~~but men moved by the~~ but men **carried along** by Holy Spirit spoke from God.

1 Corinthians 14: 34 (NASB) The women are to keep silent in the churches; for they are not permitted to speak, but are to subject themselves,
just as the Law also says.

35 If they desire to learn anything, let them ask their own husbands at home; for it is improper for a woman to speak in church.

Acts 17: 12 (Critical Text) Therefore many of them believed, along with a number of prominent Greek women

(NASB) Therefore many of them believed, along with a number of prominent Greek women and men

(Western MSS) Therefore many of them believed, along with a number of the wives of the prominent Greek men

1 Corinthians 14: 31 For you can all prophesy one by one, so that all may learn and all may be exhorted;

36 Was it from you that the word of God {first} went forth? Or has it come to you only?

1 Corinthians 11:5 But every woman who has her head uncovered while praying or prophesying disgraces her head

I Corinthians 11: 10 (NASB) the woman ought to have *a symbol of* authority on her head,

(Critical Text) a woman should have authority on her head

1 Timothy 2:12 (NASB) But I do not allow a woman to teach or exercise authority over a man, but to remain quiet.

(Critical Text) But I do not allow a woman to teach **having** authority over a man, but to **maintain a quiet spirit**.

I Timothy 2: 1-2 (Critical Text) Therefore, I exhort first of all, petitions, prayers, requests, thanksgivings be offered up for all kinds of people, for kings and everyone who is in authority, in order that we may live **a peaceful, quiet life**

I Corinthians 4: 33 (KJV) For God is not the author of confusion, but of peace

(Critical Text) God is not confusion, but peace
