#### **ADDITIONS TO THE GOSPEL DESTROY THE GOSPEL**

**Psalm 119:89** Forever, O LORD, Your word is settled in heaven.

**2 Timothy 3:16** All Scripture is ~~inspired~~ **breathed** by God

**2 Peter 1:20-21** No prophecy of Scripture is a matter of one's own interpretation, for no prophecy was ever made by an act of human will, but men ~~moved by the~~ **carried along** by Holy Spirit spoke from God.

**Romans 8:30** ... these whom He predestined, He also called; and these whom He called, He also justified; and these whom He justified, He also glorified.

**Matthew 22:14** **TR:** "For many are called, but few are chosen."

**CT:** Verse omitted

**Acts 16:31** "~~Believe in~~ "**Trust in** the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved."

**Ephesians 2:8** By grace you have been saved through faith; and that not of yourselves...

**Mark 16:16** **TR:** "He who has believed and has been baptized shall be saved"

**Ephesians 1:7** In Him we have redemption through His blood, the ~~forgiveness~~ **erasing** of our trespasses, according to the riches of His grace

**Luke 11:2-4** **TR:** ...forgive us our sins, as we also forgive everyone who is indebted to us. And do not lead us into temptation

**CT:** Forgive us our sins. **May** we also forgive everyone who is indebted to us. And lead us **away from** temptation.

**Matthew 6:14** **TR:** "For if you forgive others for their transgressions, your heavenly Father will also forgive you."

**CT:** "You forgive others for their transgressions. Your heavenly Father will also forgive you."

**6:15** **TR:** "But if you do not forgive others, then your Father will not forgive your transgressions."

**CT:** Verse omitted

**Mark 16:17-18 TR:** "These signs will accompany those who have believed: in My name they will cast out demons, they will speak with new tongues. They will pick up serpents, and if they drink any deadly poison, it will not hurt them; they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover."

**CT:** All omitted

**John 8:11 TR:** Jesus said, "I do not condemn you, either. Go. From now on sin no more."

**CT:** Entire passage omitted

**Ephesians 1:13** In Him, you also, after listening to the message of truth, the gospel of your salvation -- having also believed, you were sealed in Him with the Holy Spirit of promise

**1 John 5:13 TR** These things I have written to you who believe in the name of the Son of God, that you may know that you have eternal life, and that you may continue to believe in the name of the Son of God.

**CT:** These things I have written to you who believe in the name of the Son of God, that you may know that you have eternal life.

**Matthew 17:21 TR:** However, this kind does not go out except by prayer and fasting.

**Matthew 5:44 TR:** Love your enemies, bless those who curse you, do good to those who hate you, and pray for those who spitefully use you and persecute you.

**CT:** Love your enemies, **praying** for those who persecute you.

**Mark 6:11 TR:** And whoever will not receive you nor hear you, when you depart from there, shake off the dust under your feet as a testimony against them. Assuredly, I say to you, it will be more tolerable for Sodom and Gomorrah in the day of judgment than for that city!

**CT:** And whoever will not receive you nor hear you, when you depart from there, shake off the dust under your feet as a testimony against them.

**Galatians 1:6** I am amazed that you are so quickly deserting Him who called you by the grace of Christ, for a different gospel

**2 Corinthians 4:3-4** And even if our gospel is veiled, it is veiled to those who are perishing, in whose case the god of this world {*i.e.* Lucifer / Satan} has blinded the minds of the unbelieving so that they might not see the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God.
