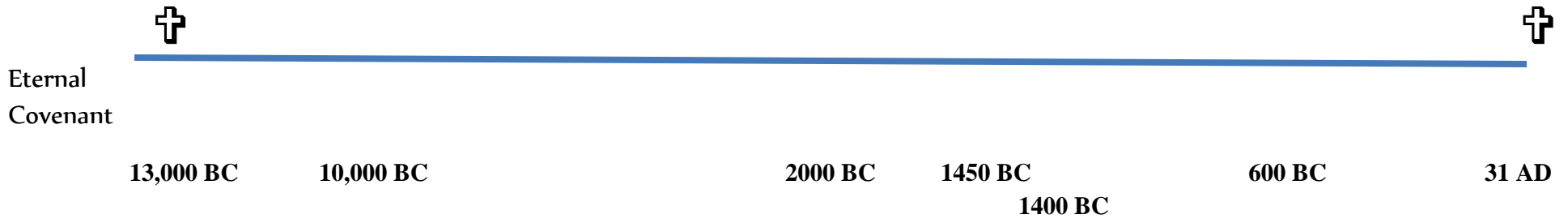


Elijah & Elisha: Correctly dividing the Word of Truth

I Kings 17:1 Now Elijah the Tishbite, who was of the settlers of Gilead, said to Ahab, "As the LORD, the God of Israel lives, before whom I stand, surely there shall be neither dew nor rain these years, except by my word."

James 5:17-18 Elijah was a man with a nature like ours, and he prayed earnestly that it would not rain, and it did not rain on the earth for three years and six months. Then he prayed again, and the sky poured rain and the earth produced its fruit.

Ephesians 3:16 that He would grant you, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with power through His Spirit in the inner man,

20 Now to Him who is able to do far more abundantly beyond all that we ask or think, according to the power that works within us,

2 Kings 2:14 He took the mantle of Elijah that fell from him and struck the waters and said, “Where is the LORD, the God of Elijah?” And when he also had struck the waters, they were divided here and there; and Elisha crossed over.

John 14:12 Truly, truly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, the works that I do, he will do also; and greater *works* than these he will do; because I go to the Father.

20 In that day you will know that I am in My Father, and you in Me, and I in you.

I Corinthians 14:1-3 Pursue love, yet desire earnestly spiritual gifts, but especially that you may prophesy.² For one who speaks in a tongue does not speak to men but to God; for no one understands, but in *his* spirit he speaks mysteries.³ But one who prophesies speaks to men for edification and exhortation and consolation.

2 Timothy 2:15 Be diligent to present yourself approved to God as a workman who does not need to be ashamed, accurately handling the word of truth.

I Chronicles 12:32 Of the sons of Issachar, men who understood the times, with knowledge of what Israel should do, their chiefs *were* two hundred; and all their kinsmen *were* at their command.

Psalms 51:16 For You do not delight in sacrifice, otherwise I would give it;
You are not pleased with burnt offering.

Deuteronomy 11:14-15 He will give the rain for your land in its season, the early and late rain, that you may gather in your grain and your new wine and your oil. He will give grass in your fields for your cattle, and you will eat and be satisfied.

16-17 Beware that your hearts are not deceived, and that you do not turn away and serve other gods and worship them. Or the anger of the LORD will be kindled against you, and He will shut up the heavens so that there will be no rain
