

Ezekiel acts out his first Six Parables

When a Believer trusts & praises the Lord  *Holy Spirit lifts & empowers Believer*

Ezekiel 3:4 Then He said to me, "Son of man, go to the house of Israel and speak with My words to them.

5 For you are not being sent to a people of unintelligible speech or difficult language, but to the house of Israel,

6 nor to many peoples of unintelligible speech or difficult language, whose words you cannot understand. But I have sent you to them who should listen to you;

7 yet the house of Israel will not be willing to listen to you, since they are not willing to listen to Me. Surely the whole house of Israel is stubborn and obstinate.

8 Behold, I have made your ~~face as hard as their faces~~ **eyebrows** as hard as their **eyebrows** and your forehead as hard as their foreheads.

12 Then the Spirit lifted me up, and I heard a great rumbling sound behind me, "Blessed be the glory of the LORD in His place."

13 And I heard the sound of the wings of the living beings touching one another and the sound of the wheels beside them, even a great rumbling sound.

Revelation 4:8 And the four living creatures, each one of them having six wings, are full of eyes around and within; and day and night they do not cease to say, "Holy , holy , holy is the Lord God , the Almighty , who was and who is and who is to come ."

Psalm 18:10 He rode upon a cherub and flew; and He sped upon the wings of the wind.

Psalm 22:3 Oh you ~~who are enthroned upon~~ who **inhabit** the praises of Israel

Psalm 103:1 ~~Bless~~ **Praise** the LORD, O my soul, and all that is within me, ~~bles~~ **praise** His holy name.

2 ~~Bless~~ **Praise** the LORD, O my soul, and forget none of His benefits;

3 Who pardons all your iniquities, who heals all your diseases;

4 Who redeems your life from the pit, who crowns you with lovingkindness and compassion

14 {NASB} So the Spirit lifted me ~~up~~ and took me ~~away~~; and I went ~~embittered in the rage~~ of my spirit, and the hand of the LORD was ~~strong on~~ me.

Septuagint: The Spirit lifted me, and took me **up**, and I went in **the impulse** of my spirit; and the hand of the LORD was **mighty upon** me.

Ezekiel 3:15 Then I came to the exiles who lived beside the river Chebar at Tel-abib, and I sat there seven days where they were living, causing consternation among them.

22 The hand of the LORD was on me there, and He said to me, "Get up, go out to the plain, and there I will speak to you."

Genesis 11:2 It came about as they journeyed east, that they found a plain in the land of Shinar and settled there.

23 So I got up and went out to the plain; and behold, the glory of the LORD was standing there, like the glory which I saw by the river Chebar, and I fell on my face.

Ezekiel 3:24 The Spirit then entered me and made me stand on my feet, and He spoke with me and said to me, "Go, shut yourself up in your house.

25 As for you, son of man, ~~they will put ropes on you and bind you with them~~ **ropes will be put** on you so that you cannot go out among them.

Ezekiel 4:8 Now behold, I will put ropes on you

Ezekiel 4:1 "Now you son of man, get yourself a brick, place it before you and inscribe a city on it, Jerusalem.

2 Then lay siege against it, build a siege wall, raise up a ramp, pitch camps and place battering rams against it all around.

3 Then get yourself an iron plate and set it up as an iron wall between you and the city, and set your face toward it so that it is under siege, and besiege it. This is a sign to the house of Israel.

Ezekiel 4:4 "As for you, lie down on your left side and lay the iniquity of the house of Israel on it; you shall bear their iniquity for the number of days that you lie on it.

5 For I have assigned you a number of days corresponding to the years of their iniquity, three hundred and ninety days; thus you shall bear the iniquity of the house of Israel.

6 When you have completed these, you shall lie down a second time, but on your right side and bear the iniquity of the house of Judah; I have assigned it to you for forty days, a day for each year.

7 Then you shall set your face toward the siege of Jerusalem with your arm bared and prophesy against it.

- Ezekiel 4:9** "But as for you, take wheat, barley, beans, lentils, millet and spelt, put them in one vessel and make them into bread for yourself; you shall eat it according to the number of the days that you lie on your side, three hundred and ninety days.
- 12** You shall eat it as a barley cake, having baked it in their sight over human dung."
- 13** Then the LORD said, "Thus will the sons of Israel eat their bread unclean among the nations where I will banish them."
- 14** But I said, "Ah, Lord GOD! Behold, I have never been defiled; for from my youth until now I have never eaten what died of itself or was torn by beasts, nor has any unclean meat ever entered my mouth."
- 15** Then He said to me, "See, I will give you cow's dung in place of human dung over which you will prepare your bread."

Ezekiel 5:1 "As for you, son of man, take a sharp sword; take and use it as a barber's razor on your head and beard. Then take scales for weighing and divide the hair.

- 2** One third you shall burn in the fire at the center of the city, when the days of the siege are completed. Then you shall take one third and strike it with the sword all around the city, and one third you shall scatter to the wind; and I will unsheathe a sword behind them.

Isaiah 28:21 He {God} will be stirred up as in the valley of Gibeon, to do His task, His unusual task, and to work His work, His ~~extraordinary~~ **strange** work.

John 5:22 {Jesus speaking} For not even the Father judges anyone, but He has given all judgment to the Son

John 8:15 {Jesus speaking} You judge according to the flesh; I am not judging anyone.

John 3:19 This is the judgment, that the Light has come into the world, and men ~~loved~~ **lovingly chose** the darkness rather than the Light, for their deeds were evil.

Matthew 12:31 "Therefore I say to you, any {other} sin and blasphemy shall be forgiven people, but blasphemy against the Spirit shall not be forgiven.

John 5:24 {Jesus speaking} "Truly, truly, I say to you, he who hears My word, and believes Him who sent Me, has eternal life, and does not come into judgment, but has passed out of death into life.

John 3:18 He who believes in Him {i.e., Jesus} is not judged; he who does not believe ~~has been judged already~~ has **already judged himself**, because he has not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God.
