

Two Parables of **JUDGMENT & Protection** *God's Emotions in Turmoil !!!*

John 5:24 "Truly, truly, I say to you, he who hears My word, and believes {*i.e.*, trusts in} Him who sent Me, has eternal life, and does not come into judgment, but has passed out of death into life."

John 3:18 He who believes {*i.e.*, trusts in} in Him is not judged; he who does not believe has been judged already, because he has not believed in {*i.e.*, trusted in} the name of the only begotten Son of God.

Ezekiel 12:1 Then the word of the LORD came to me, saying, "Son of man, you live in the midst of the rebellious house, who have eyes to see but do not see, ears to hear but do not hear; for they are a rebellious house.

3 Therefore, son of man, prepare for yourself baggage for exile and go into exile by day ~~in their sight~~ **in the street**; even go into exile from your place to another ~~place~~ **house** in their sight. Perhaps they will understand though they are a rebellious house.

5 Dig a hole through the wall and go out through it.

7 So in the evening I dug through the wall with my hands; I went out in the dark and carried the baggage on my shoulder ~~in their sight~~ **in the street**.

8-9 In the morning the word of the LORD came to me, saying, "Son of man, has not the house of Israel, the rebellious house, said to you, 'What are you doing?'"

10 Say to them, "Thus says the Lord GOD, "This burden concerns the prince in Jerusalem as well as all the house of Israel who are in it.""

Jeremiah 39:1 Now when Jerusalem was captured in the ninth year of Zedekiah king of Judah, in the tenth month, Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon and all his army came to Jerusalem and laid siege to it;

2 in the eleventh year of Zedekiah, in the fourth month, in the ninth day of the month, the city wall was breached.

3 Then all the officials of the king of Babylon came in and sat down at the Middle Gate: Nergal-sar-ezer, Samgar-nebu, Sar-sekim the Rab-saris, Nergal-sar-ezer the Rab-mag, and all the rest of the officials of the king of Babylon.

4 When Zedekiah the king of Judah and all the men of war saw them, they fled and went out of the city at night by way of the king's garden through the gate between the two walls; and he went out toward the Arabah.

5 But the army of the Chaldeans pursued them and overtook Zedekiah in the plains of Jericho; and they seized him and brought him up to Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon at Riblah in the land of Hamath, and he passed sentence on him.

6-7 Then the king of Babylon slew the sons of Zedekiah before his eyes at Riblah; the king of Babylon also slew all the nobles of Judah. He then blinded Zedekiah's eyes and bound him in fetters of bronze to bring him to Babylon.

8 The Chaldeans also burned with fire the king's palace and the houses of the people, and they broke down the walls of Jerusalem.

9 As for the rest of the people who were left in the city, the deserters who had gone over to him and the rest of the people who remained, Nebuzaradan the captain of the bodyguard carried them into exile in Babylon.

10 But some of the poorest people who had nothing, Nebuzaradan the captain of the bodyguard left behind in the land of Judah, and gave them vineyards and fields at that time.

11-12 Now Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon gave orders about Jeremiah through Nebuzaradan the captain of the bodyguard, saying, "Take him and look after him, and do nothing harmful to him, but rather deal with him just as he tells you."

Psalm 5:12 For it is You who blesses the righteous man, O LORD, You surround him with favor as with a shield.

Philippians 3:9 and may be found in Him, not having a righteousness of my own derived from ~~the Law~~ **law**, but that which is through faith in Christ, the righteousness which comes from God on the basis of faith **Romans 3:10** There is none righteous, no, not one

17-18 Moreover, the word of the LORD came to me saying, "Son of man, eat your bread with trembling and drink your water with quivering and anxiety.

19 Then say to the people of the land, "Thus says the Lord GOD concerning the inhabitants of Jerusalem in the land of Israel, "They will eat their bread with anxiety and drink their water with horror, because their land will be stripped of its fullness on account of the violence of all who live in it.

20 The inhabited cities will be laid waste and the land will be a desolation. So you will know that I am the LORD."

Matthew 9:35 Jesus was going through all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues and proclaiming the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every kind of disease and every kind of sickness.

Matthew 24:21 For then there will be a great tribulation, such as has not occurred since the beginning of the world until now, nor ever will.

Romans 6:23 For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Hosea 11:8 How can I give you up, O Ephraim? How can I surrender you, O Israel? ... My heart is turned over within Me, all My compassions are kindled.

Isaiah 53:3 He was despised and forsaken of men, A man of sorrows and acquainted with grief...

4 – 5 Surely our griefs He Himself bore, and our sorrows He carried; ... He was pierced through for our transgressions, He was crushed for our ~~iniquities~~ **iniquity**; the chastening for our well-being {peace} fell upon Him, and by His scourging we are healed.

10 But the LORD ~~was pleased~~ **wanted** to crush Him, putting Him to grief; if He would render Himself as a guilt offering, He will see His offspring

Hebrews 12:2 ~~fixing~~ **So let's just keep** our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of faith {i.e., the One who brings our faith to completion}, who for the joy set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.

Matthew 26:29 But I say to you, I will not drink of this fruit of the vine from now on until that day when I drink it new with you in My Father's kingdom."

Jeremiah 31:3 I have loved you with an everlasting love; therefore I have drawn you with lovingkindness.

Ephesians 3:16-19 that He would grant you, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with power through His Spirit in the inner man, so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith; and that you, being rooted and grounded in love, may be able to ~~comprehend~~ **seize** {i.e., grab onto} with all the saints what is the breadth and length and height and depth, and to know the love of Christ which surpasses knowledge, that you may be filled up to all the fullness of God.

20 Now to Him who ~~is able to~~ **has the power** to do far more abundantly beyond all that we ask or think, according to the power that ~~works within us~~ **energizes us internally**.
