I was amazed and happy to see the tribute to Black History Month.


The message on Augustine was very informative



Thank you for writing.

The correct reading is "the dragon stood on the sand of the seashore"

The dragon is, of course, Lucifer (Revelation 12:9 "And the great dragon was thrown down, the serpent of old who is called the devil and Satan")

The sand on the seashore is a picture of the Jews (Genesis 22:17 "indeed I will greatly bless you, and I will greatly multiply your seed as the stars of the heavens and as the sand which is on the seashore")

The sea is a picture of the Gentile world (Rev 17:15 "And he said to me, "The waters which you saw where the harlot sits, are peoples and multitudes and nations and tongues.""

So, to put this together, during the Great Tribulation, Lucifer will deceive Israel into thinking that his representative, Antichrist, is their Messiah. He will turn against them and, temporarily, subjugate them.

So, the image of Lucifer standing on the beach represents his watching the world of the Gentiles to see when God will allow him to possess the Gentile Antichrist.

We are already seeing Lucifer's preparatory work as his demons possess more and more leaders in Europe and America.

Good news -- the Rapture must be near!






