

Isaiah 7  
**God's Christmas Card**

**Matthew 1:21** She will bear a Son; and you shall call His name Jesus, for He will save His people from their sins."

**22-23** Now all this took place to fulfill what was spoken by the Lord through the prophet: "BEHOLD, THE VIRGIN SHALL BE WITH CHILD AND SHALL BEAR A SON, AND THEY SHALL CALL HIS NAME IMMANUEL," which translated means, "GOD WITH US."

**Isaiah 1:2** "Sons I have reared and brought up, but they have revolted against Me."

**Isaiah 6:1** In the year of King Uzziah's death I saw the Lord sitting on a throne, lofty and exalted, with the train of His robe filling the temple.

**2-3** Seraphim stood above Him, each having six wings: with two he covered his face, and with two he covered his feet, and with two he flew. And one called out to another and said, "Holy, Holy, Holy, is the LORD of hosts, the whole earth is full of His glory."

**Isaiah 9:16** Those who guide this people are leading them astray

**Isaiah 1:5-6** The whole head is sick and the whole heart is faint. From the sole of the foot even to the head there is nothing sound in it, only bruises, welts and raw wounds, not pressed out or bandaged, nor softened with oil.

**Isaiah 7:2** When it was reported to the house of David, saying, "The Arameans have camped in Ephraim," his heart and the hearts of his people shook as the trees of the forest shake with the wind.

**3-4** Then the LORD said to Isaiah, "Go out now to meet Ahaz, you and your son Shear-jashub, at the end of the conduit of the upper pool, on the highway to the fuller's field, and say to him, 'Take care and be calm, have no fear and do not be fainthearted because of these two stubs of smoldering firebrands.'

**10-11** Then the LORD spoke again to Ahaz, saying, "Ask a sign for yourself from the LORD your God; make it deep as Sheol or high as heaven."

**12** But Ahaz said, "I will not ask, nor will I test the LORD!"

**14** Therefore the Lord Himself will give you a sign: Behold, a virgin {or, *young woman*} will be with child and bear a son, and she will call His name Immanuel.

**Isaiah 8:4** for before the boy knows how to cry out ~~'My father' or 'My mother'~~ **'Dada' or 'Mama'**, the wealth of Damascus and the spoil of Samaria will be carried away before the king of Assyria."

**Isaiah 9:6** For a child will be born to us, a son will be given to us;

and the government will rest on His shoulders;

and His name will be called ~~Wonderful Counselor,~~ **Wonderful! Friend! (Wonderful Friend!)**

**Mighty God! Out of the Eternal Father! Prince of Peace!**

**7** There will be no end to the increase of His government or of peace,

on the throne of David and over his kingdom,

to establish it and to uphold it with justice and righteousness

from then on and forevermore.

**Isaiah 8:12** You are not to fear what they fear or be in dread of it.

**17** I will ~~wait for~~ **look expectantly to** the LORD who is hiding His face from the house of Jacob; I will ~~even look~~ **keep looking** eagerly for Him.

**Isaiah 7:3** Then the LORD said to Isaiah, "Go out now to meet Ahaz, you and your son Shear-jashub, at the end of the conduit of the upper pool, on the highway to the fuller's field,

**4** and say to him, "Take care and be calm, have no fear"

**Zephaniah 3:17** "The LORD your God is in your midst, A victorious warrior.

He will exult over you with joy, He will be quiet in His love,

He will rejoice over you with shouts of joy.
