Abraham said to his young men, "Stay here with the donkey, and I and the lad will go over there; and we will worship and return to you."

7 Isaac spoke to Abraham his father and said, "My father!" And he said, "Here I am, my son." And he said, "Behold, the fire and the wood, but where is the lamb for the burnt offering?"

8 ~~Abraham said, "God will provide for Himself the lamb for the burnt offering, my son."~~

Abraham said, "God will provide **Himself, the lamb,** for the burnt offering, my son." So the two of them walked on together.



9 – 10 Then they came to the place of which God had told him; and Abraham built the altar there and arranged the wood, and bound his son Isaac and laid him on the altar, on top of the wood. Abraham stretched out his hand and took the knife ~~to slay~~ **which would** slay his son.

13 Then Abraham raised his eyes and looked, and behold, behind him a ram caught in the thicket by his horns; and Abraham went and took the ram and offered him up for a burnt offering in the place of his son.

14 Abraham called the name of that place The LORD Will Provide, as it is said to this day, "In the mount of the LORD it will be provided."

Genesis 15:6 And Abraham believed God and it was credited to him as righteousness

Leviticus 11:3 Whatever divides a hoof, thus making split hoofs, and chews the cud, among the animals, that you may eat.
