Boxing in God’s Gym – **THE OLD ONE-TWO**

Hebrews 12:1 Let us lay aside every encumbrance and the sin which so easily entangles us

2 fixing our eyes on Jesus

3 For consider Him who has endured such hostility by sinners against Himself, so that you will not grow weary and lose heart.

4 You have not yet resisted to the point of shedding blood in your ~~striving~~ **boxing** against sin;

5 and you have forgotten ~~the exhortation~~ **the dialog** which is addressed to you as sons,

“My son, ~~do not regard lightly the discipline~~ **do not despise the developmental training** of the Lord,

~~Nor faint~~ **Nor become weak-kneed** when you are ~~reproved~~ **re-proved** {i.e. proved again} by Him;

6 For those whom the Lord loves He ~~disciplines~~ **developmentally trains**,

And He ~~scourges~~ **develops through training** every son whom He receives.”

Psalms 84:11 No good thing does He withhold from those ~~who walk uprightly~~ **who are the righteous**

11 ~~All discipline~~ **Developmental training** for the moment seems not to be joyful, but sorrowful;

yet to those who have been trained by it, afterwards it yields the peaceful fruit of righteousness.

Lamentations 5:17 Because of this our heart is faint, because of these things our eyes are dim

Proverbs 29:18 Where there is no **clear** vision, the people ~~perish~~ **are out of control**

Lamentations 3:52 My enemies without cause hunted me down like a bird;

1:13 He has made me desolate, faint all day long

James 1:2-4 ~~Consider it~~ as all joy, my brethren, when ~~you encounter various trials~~, knowing that the ~~testing~~ of your faith produces ~~endurance~~. And let ~~endurance~~ have its perfect result, so that you may be ~~perfect~~ and complete, lacking in nothing.

(Critical text) **Mark it down** as all joy, my **brothers and sisters**, when **as you are walking along, you run into different kinds of difficulties**, knowing that the **proving** of your faith produces **resilience**. And let **resilience** have its perfect result, so that you may be **mature** and complete, lacking in nothing.

I John 4:18 There is no fear in love; but perfect love {*i.e.* love that brings about the desired purpose} casts out fear, because fear involves punishment, and the one who fears is not being perfected in love

Isaiah 40:31 Yet those who wait for the LORD will gain new strength
