John 19:30 When Jesus had received the sour wine, He said, "It is finished!" "Paid in full!"

Galatians 3:13 Christ redeemed us from the curse of the Law, having become a curse for us -- for it is written, "Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree"

Romans 10:4 Christ is the end of the law the end of law for righteousness to everyone who believes.

Ephesians 1:7 In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of His grace

1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Colossians 1:22 He has now reconciled you in His fleshly body through death, in order to present you before Him holy and blameless and beyond reproach

And let **resilience** have its perfect result, so that you may be **mature** {i.e., fully developed} and complete, lacking in nothing.
