Johnny's reply: Once again with the proviso that compared to you I don't know what I'm talking about, yes I do. It seems to me that Hawking has steered the entire argument in the wrong direction with his theory of the different dimensions being "unpacked" at staggered intervals. He has forgotten that since the universe is flat, Euclidean geometry is still valid for describing the large scale vectors that define the dark matter.

I believe that all of the dimensions were unpacked instantly at the singularity – in accordance with elementary Euclidean equations.
