

## The Transfiguration

***Jesus filled full the law and the prophets for every born again believer***

**Matthew 16:28** "Truly I say to you, there are some of those who are standing here who will not taste death until they see the Son of Man coming in His kingdom."

**Matthew 17:1** Six days later Jesus took with Him Peter and James and John his brother, and led them up on a high mountain by themselves.

2 And He was transfigured before them; and His face shone like the sun, and His garments became as white as light.

**Luke 9:29** And while He was praying, the appearance of His face became different

3 And ~~behold~~ look, Moses and Elijah appeared to them, talking with Him.

**Matthew 11:13** All the prophets and the Law prophesied until John.

**Luke 9:30** Behold, two men were talking with Him; and they were Moses and Elijah,

31 who, appearing in glory, were speaking of His departure which He was about to accomplish at Jerusalem.

**Matthew 5:17** "Do not think that I came to abolish the Law or the Prophets; I did not come to abolish but ~~to fulfill~~ to fill full.

4 Peter said to Jesus, "Lord, it is good for us to be here; if You wish, I will make three tabernacles here, one for You, and one for Moses, and one for Elijah."

**Mark 9:6** He did not know what to answer; for they became terrified.

5 While he was still speaking, a bright cloud overshadowed them, and behold, a voice out of the cloud said, "This is My beloved Son, with whom I am well-pleased; listen to Him!"

**6-8** When the disciples heard this, they fell face down to the ground and were terrified. And Jesus came to them and touched them and said, "Get up, and do not be afraid." And lifting up their eyes, they saw no one except Jesus Himself alone.

**I Thessalonians 5:18** In **the middles of all things**, give thanks

**Psalms 5:12** For it is You who blesses the righteous man, O LORD, You surround him with favor as with a shield.

**2 Corinthians 5:21** He made Him who knew no sin to be sin ~~on our behalf~~ **in our place**, so that we ~~might~~ **would** become the righteousness of God in Him.

**Philippians 3:9** ...not having ~~a righteousness of my own derived~~ **my own righteousness** from the Law, but that which is through faith in Christ, the righteousness which comes from God on the basis of faith,

**Leviticus 11:45** "You shall be holy, for I am holy."

**Hebrews 10:10** We have been sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all

**Colossians 1:10** ...so that you will walk ~~in a manner worthy of the Lord, to please Him in all respects~~ **equal to** the Lord in all **pleasant ways**,

**1 Thessalonians 4:1** ~~Finally then, brethren, we request and exhort you in the Lord Jesus, that as you received from us instruction as to how you ought to walk and please God (just as you actually do walk), that you excel still more.~~

Finally, **brothers and sisters** in the Lord Jesus, we request and exhort you in the Lord Jesus, how you **are required** to walk {i.e., live} and please God (just as you actually **are walking**). **Now we encourage you to abound** {i.e., have} **even** more.

**Romans 6:14** ~~Sin shall~~ Sin **will** not be master over you, for you are not under law but under grace.

**2 Corinthians 4:7** But we have this treasure in earthen vessels

**John 8:32** you will know the truth, and the truth will make you free.
